NCC to build new school and sports hall in Filipstad

NCC, in partnership with Filipstad Municipality, will build a new school with places for 360 students and a sports hall in central Filipstad. The order value is approximately SEK 180 million.

“It is extremely gratifying to be able to give both education and sports in our municipality such fine conditions for their operations. This will be a ‘no-shoes’ school, with modern and well-designed learning environments. Through an early partnership with NCC, we can build a school for today and tomorrow,” says Jomark Polintan, Deputy Chairman of the Municipal Board and chair of the technology committee in Filipstad Municipality.

The new school will be built in central Filipstad, on a site where a school previously stood. The three-story school will house 360 students in preschool, grades 1 through 3 and elementary special education. The first story will house shared spaces, including a canteen and reception kitchen. The second story has spaces for preschool classes, grade 1 and special education classes. Uppermost are the classrooms for grade 2 and 3, as well as premises for handicraft lessons. Solar cells will be placed on the roof, and the school will be constructed in accordance with the Sweden Green Building Council, Silver level.

A new sports hall will be built adjacent to the Spångberg Hall sports facility. The stands in the sports hall will seat approximately 400 spectators across two levels.

The assignment is a turnkey contract, and the collaboration is in the form of a partnering arrangement in which NCC and Filipstad Municipality will complete the assignment in an atmosphere of open dialogue with the best interests of the project in focus. The collaboration was inaugurated in May of 2019, with project planning in an introductory initial phase. The parties have now reached an agreement regarding the scope, and a construction contract has been signed.

“NCC is one of Sweden’s largest builders of schools and we are bringing all our experience to Filipstad’s new school. During the planning, we collaborated closely with representatives from the operations, and we look forward to building the learning environments of the future that will meet the needs of both students and teachers,” says Sandra Björn, Project Director, NCC Building Sweden.

Construction will commence in early 2021. Completion of the school is planned for late 2022.

The assignment is valued at approximately SEK 180 million and will be registered among orders in the first quarter of 2021 in the NCC Building Sweden business area.
